

ABOUT AMALINDA LODGE



An African inspired refuge, where world class facilities combine the cultural and spiritual energy, allure and unique beauty for which the Matobo Hills is renowned and celebrated.

This exclusive, privately owned safari lodge is located in the UNESCO World Heritage Site of the Matobo Hills, the oldest National Park in Zimbabwe. The granite domes and castle kopjes echo the essence of tranquillity and majesty of untamed Africa, where wildlife and birdlife species thrive in prolific numbers.

Famous for its healthy population of endangered rhino, the area is one of the most sought after destinations within Zimbabwe.

LOCATION



Amalinda Lodge, A Wilderness of Granite, is situated 45 kilometres south of Bulawayo on the Matopos road. The Matopos region has been classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is home to the highest concentration of rock art in Southern Africa.

Malaria: The Matopos is not a Malaria Area



This is your private wilderness of granite, a wonderful opportunity to disconnect from reality and reconnect with family and nature. The Private Villa consist of 1 deluxe en-suite main room, 1 standard room and one twin room both sharing a bathroom. Every room has a private viewing deck, open plan kitchen, inside and outside dining area, private boma & BBQ area, private guide, host/hostess and chef, as well as access to Amalinda Lodge's facilities such as the spa, pool and dining area.



ACCOMMODATION



The lodges are set within the granite boulders on different levels and each have a distinctive look and feel. There are 9 lodges in total comprising of 3 suites, 3 family rooms (with 2 double beds in each), 2 double rooms and 1 twin room.

Amalinda's lodges all have electric blankets for the winter season. Each room has an en-suite bathroom built into the granite rock face, giving a unique accommodation experience. Tea and Nespresso coffee stations come standard in each room.


You will be led by our knowledgeable and professional guides through this enchanting area. Your choice of activities include:

ACCESS



Bulawayo Airport is only 60km from Amalinda Lodge & is serviced by direct flights from Victoria Falls, Harare & Johannesburg. Our transfer company 'Driving You Wild' can assist in transfers nationwide. Destinations leading into Bulawayo are Harare (439km), Victoria Falls (437 km), Masvingo (298km), Beitbridge on the South African Border (322 km) and Plumtree on the Botswana border (102 km). It is not necessary to travel in a 4 X 4 vehicle.




